MEDICAL EXAM CHECKLIST-CLASS II/III

Prior to your exam, please follow these steps to ensure a smooth process.



PRIOR TO EXAM (5-7 DAYS)

- The week of the exam, logon to Medexpress: <u>https://medxpress.faa.gov/MedXpress/Login.aspx</u>
- Complete the application process, save and/or print the responses and save for future use
 If no medical history (Item 18) and/or positive response, then submit and save the confirmation number
 If any medical history (Item 18), then save, but do not submit, and contact your AME to discuss
- □ If prior special issuance, CACI, SODA or prior Deferments, then review AME Guide and ensure proper documentation (contact AME to discuss if any questions) <u>https://www.faa.gov/ame_guide</u>
- □ Plan to bring corrective lenses/contacts; ensure prescription is up to date

PRIOR TO EXAM (1-2 DAYS)

- □ Once you have your confirmation number, confirm date and time of exam. The medical exam is necessary to get your medical certificate, which will be provided if no issues during exam
- Arrange for chaperone if desired (for males); a chaperone is mandatory for females

- □ Bring a form of identification (passport, driver's license)
- □ Bring medical records
